



The University of Kitakyushu, located on the southern island of Kyushu, Japan, is a long-time ODU partner that has offered **Old Dominion University the opportunity to send one faculty member to teach a brief American Society/American Culture related course to their students this summer.** Classes will be conducted for one week in late August, 2013.

The ODU faculty member will have 15 contact hours for teaching during the one week (3 hours per day for 5 days or 5 hours per day for 3 days). Typically, faculty have chosen to teach three 90 minute courses each day for 5 days. The rate of compensation for each class is about 11,700 yen per class (approximately \$120 USD). Housing will be provided by the University of Kitakyushu and airfare will be provided by the Office of International Programs.

The program is open to full-time faculty from any discipline.
