#### History/Purpose

President John R. Broderick and First Lady Kate Broderick established the Broderick – Evon Award for Community Engagement and Service in honor of Ellen Broderick and Joan Evon. The prize will be awarded to any sophomore or junior who has displayed commitment to service and civic engagement to the university and surrounding community through superior leadership and service.

#### Application Requirements

1. All components of this application packet must arrive to the Office of Student Engagement & Enrollment Services (2008, Webb Center) by **5 p.m. on Friday, March 8, 2013**. Any material submitted after the **March 8** deadline will **not** be accepted.
2. All attachments must be typed.
3. Completed application may not exceed 10 pages.
4. Do not staple or bind supplemental/supporting documents.
5. A letter of support from a faculty, staff, chaplain, or alumnus of the University must be submitted via email to [dstansbe@odu.edu](mailto:dstansbe@odu.edu) by the established deadline.
6. Two letters of recommendation written by people who know the merits of your work or can cite examples of your character, leadership, and academic ability must accompany this application. Each letter must contain the individuals contact information, their relationship to you, and the length of time they have known you, must be submitted to [dstansbe@odu.edu](mailto:dstansbe@odu.edu) by the established deadline.
7. Before submission, please select if you will be attending the Student Award Dinner on May 9, 2013 and list attendees.

#### Selection Procedure

1. The applicant package will be reviewed by a selection committee chaired by the Vice President for Student Engagement and Enrollment Services and will be comprised of the following individuals: Assistant Vice President for Community Engagement, a Broderick or Evon family member, a faculty representative, and a student government representative.
2. The screening committee will identify the finalists and then conduct personal interviews on **March 28**.
