The Women's Studies Department at Old Dominion University is planning a resumption of Works in Progress, the conference of feminist scholarship of earlier decades. It will be held on Saturday, April 5, 2014, in the Batten Arts and Letters Building on the ODU campus.

As before, this will be a nonjuried conference: anyone whose research deals with women, gender and/or sexuality is welcome to make a proposal and will be placed on an appropriate panel. You may try something new or share a completed paper (or piece of creative writing) that colleagues in other disciplines or other universities in the area have not had a chance to hear. WIP is also a supportive setting for novice researchers to give papers. And of course WIP gives us the opportunity to see old friends and to make new ones. Panels comprised of three presentations will last for 90 minutes: 20 minutes for each presentation and 30 minutes for questions and discussion. Please submit a proposal of 200-350 words describing your paper (or creative work) in enough detail that we will be able to place you on a panel that shares themes or perspectives, even across disciplinary lines.

Deadline for submissions is **Monday, March 3, 2014.**
