Fortune 500 shipbuilding company headquartered in Newport News, VA. HII is the sole designer, builder, and refueler of nuclear-powered aircraft carriers in the United States. It is one of two nuclear-powered submarine builders. 70% of the current, active US Navy fleet has been built by HII. HII's current order backlog amounts to \$22.4 billion.

HII operates facilities in several key locations across the US:

- Newport News Shipbuilding, Newport News, Virginia (nuclear aircraft carriers, submarines, overhaul)
- Ingalls Shipbuilding, Pascagoula, Mississippi (surface combatants, amphibs, Coast Guard large cutters)
- Virginia Beach, Virginia (AMSEC, fleet support)
- San Diego, California (continental maritime, fleet repair and support)
- Gulfport, Mississippi (composite R&D, composite components)
