

Students on this multi-day program will have the opportunity to practice their French language skills through real life, immersive experiences in Québec, Canada. This program is structured to enhance spoken French language learning through intensive language training coupled with experiences focused on Québécois identity and culture in Montréal and Québec City. Through a combination of classroom study and co-curricular activities, students will expand their French language skills while experiencing Québécois identity and culture as formed and expressed through history, arts and architecture, literature and language, societal and governmental practice and policy, cuisine, and other aspects. An excursion to Québec City is also included.
