



What is M-Power?

- A resource within the ODU community, educating on issues of interpersonal violence (sexual assault, stalking, and intimate partner abuse)
- Peer educators provide learning experiences that promote gender equality, non-violence and positive change

What will you gain?

- Public speaking practice, skills, and experience
- Facilitation skills enabling you to engage others in learning activities, bring different opinions into the open for discussion, and answer difficult questions within a group setting
- Knowledge and experience in advocating on an important issue and for those adversely impacted
- Greater awareness, compassion, and sense of responsibility for your peers
- Community service hours

Who should apply?

- Any sophomore through graduate level student currently enrolled at ODU, with the courage and desire to make a difference
- Students with a basic understanding of these topics
- Students who desire to be agents of change

What is required of the peer educator?

- Complete 17 hours of training in September.
- Present a minimum of two interactive presentations per academic year.
- * Assist with Women's Center awareness events and programs throughout the school year
- * Attend monthy peer educator meetings to keep current on issues of interpersonal violence.
