# Old Dominion University Evon – Broderick Award

#### History/Purpose

The application for one of Old Dominion University's most prestigious honors and awards is below.

In 2011, President Emeritus John R. Broderick, Old Dominion University's 8th President, and First Lady Emerita Kate Broderick, with the help of other family members who choose to remain anonymous, established and endowed the Evon-Broderick Award for Community Engagement and Service in honor of their mothers Joan Evon and Ellen Broderick.

This esteemed honor recognizes ODU students, who like the award's namesakes, exemplify a commitment to service and civic engagement to the university and surrounding community through superior leadership and service. **It is open to any currently enrolled sophomore or junior**. Sophomores must have completed 30 semester hours and juniors must have completed 60 credit hours and no more than 89 credit hours.

This endowment awards funding to the best of the Old Dominion University civically engaged students and aims to inspire a lifelong dedication to the pursuit of service.

## **Application Requirements**

- 1. The application packet must arrive to the Dean of Students Office, Student Engagement & Enrollment Services (2008, Webb Center) or emailed to deanofstudents@odu.edu by 5 p.m., March 4. Any material submitted after the March 4 deadline will not be accepted.
- 2. All attachments must be typed.
- 3. Completed application may not exceed 10 pages.
- 4. Do not staple or bind supplemental/supporting documents.
- 5. Three letters of recommendation written by people who know the merits of your work or can cite examples of your character, leadership, and academic ability must accompany this application. Letters should be written by faculty members, advisors, or supervisors. Each letter must contain the individuals contact information, their relationship to you, and the length of time they have known you, must be submitted to deanofstudents@odu.edu by the established deadline.
- 6. All participants are encouraged to have their materials reviewed by Career Development Services and the ODU Writing Center, prior to submission. Grammar, punctuation and clarity will be evaluated.

#### **Selection Procedure**

- 1. The applicant package will be reviewed by a selection committee chaired by the Vice President for Student Engagement & Enrollment Services and will be comprised of the following individuals: Assistant Vice President for Community Engagement, a Broderick or Evon family member, a faculty representative, and a student government representative.
- 2. The screening committee will identify the finalists and then conduct personal interviews.
