Criteria:

- Student must be a senior who is enrolled in the ODU College of Health Sciences
- Student must be full-time (at least 12 credit hours) in Spring 2021 semester.
- Student must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- The internship must be completed prior to graduation
- Student must demonstrate knowledge in these areas:
 - Data collection, entry, and analysis
 - Literature review and composition of internal and external documents
