

## College of Health Sciences Outstanding Faculty Teaching Award

### **Description**

This award is to recognize a full-time faculty member within the College of Health Sciences who is outstanding in teaching. The awardee should have excellent teaching records in the classroom or clinical setting as an instructor.

### **Eligibility**

- ✓ Must be a full-time faculty member with at least three years' experience
- ✓ Must teach an average of 6 credit hours per semester
- ✓ Faculty who have received this award in the last three years are not eligible

### **Application Materials:**

1. *Completed nomination form*
2. *Letter of nomination*
3. *One letter of support:* The nomination and/or support letter should include at least one from a student and one faculty member who can speak to the nominee's teaching abilities.
4. *Curriculum vitae*
5. Peer review of teaching portfolio from the previous year
6. *One page philosophy of teaching*

### **Submission and Deadline:**

All materials should be converted into **ONE PDF** file and emailed to Courtnee Matthews at the Dean's Office (Email: [c1matthe@odu.edu](mailto:c1matthe@odu.edu)) by **July 15, 2023**.

Please do not submit files separately or send hard copies. It is the nominator's responsibility to submit the requested materials by the deadline. The committee will only consider application materials requested above.

### **Awards:**

The awardee will receive a certificate of recognition with \$500.
