Vision

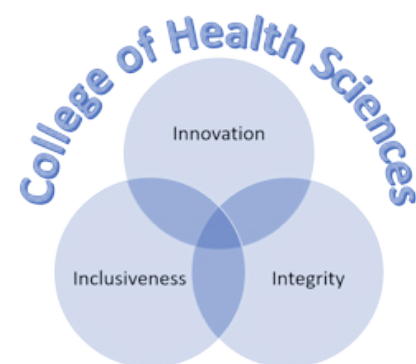
Our vision is to promote and achieve excellence in healthcare education and scholarship through innovative interdisciplinary approaches which empower our global community.

Innovation: novelty, origination, creativity, transformation, new imaginations, better solutions, reimagining

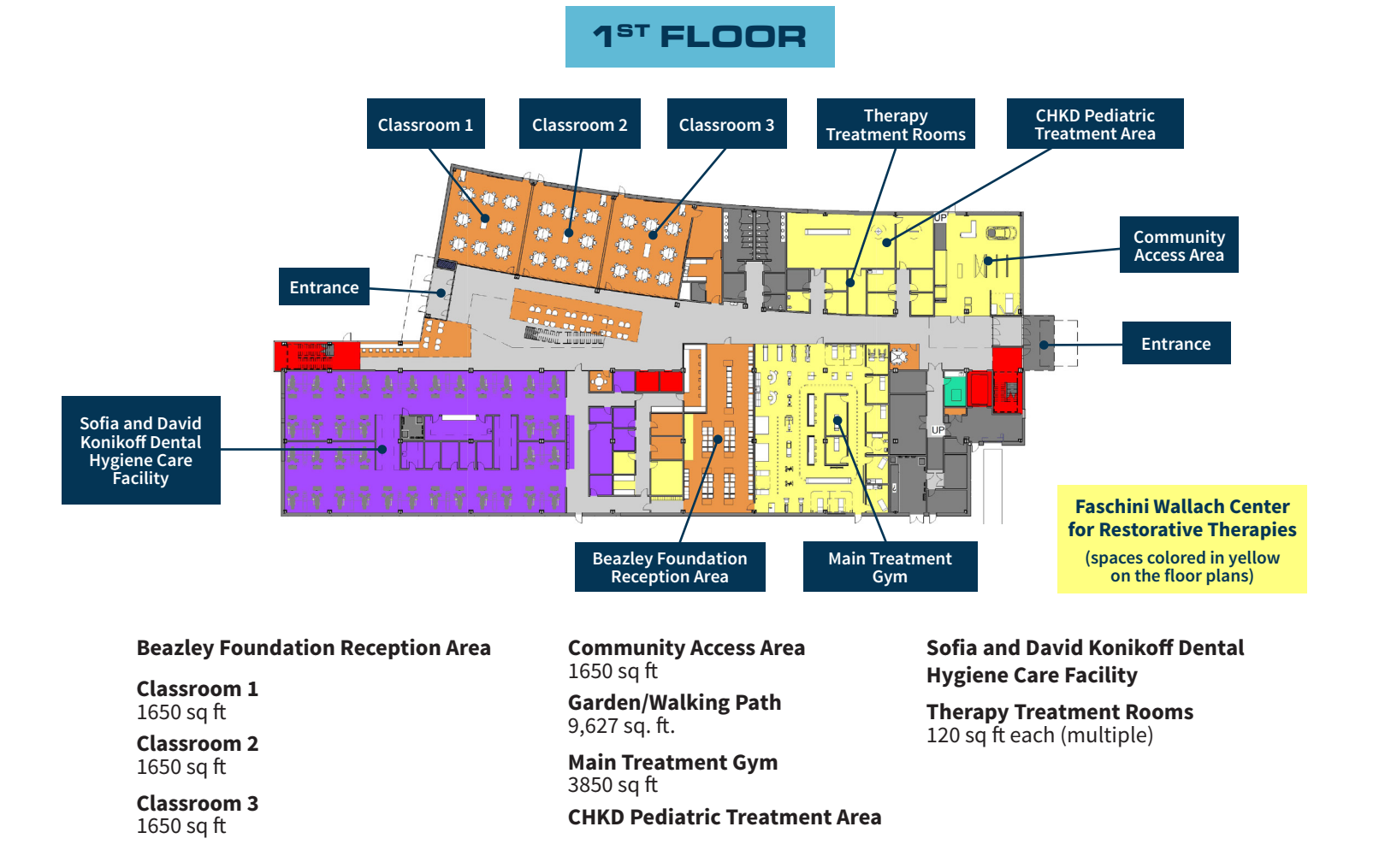
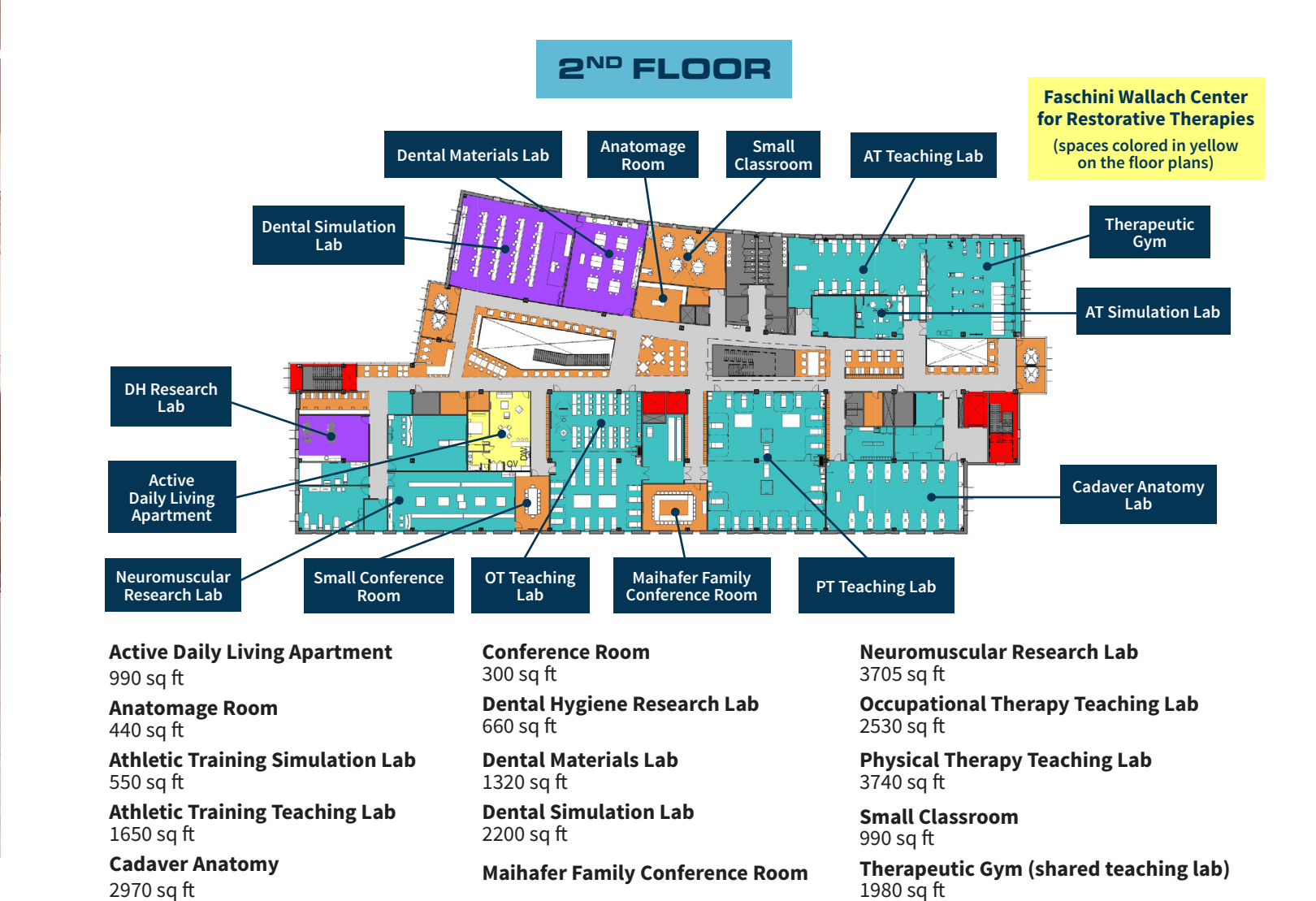
