Delaying admission to the undergraduate teacher education program will adversely affect your ability to complete this program in 4 years. *If credit is received for ARTH 121A, majors must take MUSC 308 or 460. If credit is received for MUSC 264A, majors must take ARTS 305. Distance Learning students should take ARTH 121A or its equivalent and MUSC 460.

**Majors must complete one Lecture/Lab course in BIOL and one Lecture/Lab course in either PHYS (preferred) or CHEM.

***Majors must complete both MATH 335 & MATH 302.
