****PROGRAM ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS for Students without Licensure, A.A.S. Degree and/or Certification:** Students who do not have a current license as a health professional, an Associate of Applied Science degree, or a certification must complete CHP 200, 328, 335 and 390 before applying to program. Admission into ODU does not guarantee admission into the B.S.H.S. program. Eligibility must be documented with a separate admission form to the B.S.H.S. program director.

*****Major Elective Courses:** Students without licensure, an A.A.S. degree or certification must select five CHP courses or related courses in addition to the courses selected to meet departmental requirements. CHP 360, 400, 415W, 426 & 427, 430W, 445, 450, 465, 475, 480, 485, ENVH 301W/401, DNTH 415, MEDT 403W, NMED 300 or any CHP course by permission.

****For the **Concentration in Health Services Administration** students must complete the following coursework: MGMT 325 and MGMT 340, 350, 360, 417, 418, 451, 452 or 462. For the **Minor in Human Services** students must complete the following coursework: HMSV 339, 341, 343W, 346 and HMSV 344, 447, 448, 449 or 491.

NOTE: Foreign language may be satisfied with 3 years of 1 or 2 years of 2 languages in high school; graduation from HS prior to 12/31/85, or with AA or AS Degree from VCCS.
