


Canvas Gradebook: Additional Student Information


By default, the Canvas gradebook provides limited information about each student enrolled in a course. From the User Interface, you'll typically only see your students' names along with graded assignment/assessment columns like this:


You may want to view student UINs alongside student names. In Canvas, a student's UIN is labeled **Integration ID**. Here's how to view that ID in the gradebook:

1. Open the course gradebook.
2. Mouse over the **Student Name** column header to reveal three vertical dots.

3. Click the three dots to sort the Gradebook by name or ID.
