Parking

All on-campus parking requires a valid ODU Parking Permit or Hourly parking payment. ODU utilizes a virtual permit system and License Plate Recognition (LPR) to enforce parking.

Student Parking

Freshman and Upperclassmen alike are able and required to purchase a parking permit in order to park a vehicle on campus. ODU Commuter and Resident Student Semester Permits can be purchased online at odu.edu/parking. Monthly, Weekly, & Daily permit options are also available. See front of map for the QR code to parking lot maps for each permit type.

Faculty/Staff

Faculty/Staff Permits are renewed annually each Fall and can be purchased online at odu.edu/parking. Monthly, Weekly, & Daily permit options are also available. See our website for Faculty/Staff parking locations.

Short Term Parking

Daily, Weekly, & Monthly Permits are available to anyone parking on campus and are valid in any Faculty/Staff, Commuter, or Resident location and can be purchased online at odu.edu/parking

ADA Accessible Parking

Accessible parking spaces are located in every garage and lot Hourly Parking is \$1.50/hour and pay-by-plate. on campus. State-issued accessible parking placards must be accompanied by a valid ODU parking permit or Hourly parking payment.

Citations & Appeals

Citations will be issued for violations of ODU TPS Rules & Regulations (available online at odu.edu/parking)

Appeals: MUST be submitted online within 7 calendar days of citation issue.

Re-Appeals: If the appeal is denied, payment is required before the second appeal is reviewed by a committee. **Booting & Towing**: Vehicles with more than \$100 in citations may be booted and/or towed at the owner's expense.

Motorcycle/Moped Parking

Two-wheeled motor vehicles require a permit and must be parked in the designated striped and signed areas in garages and parking lots. Motorcycles & Mopeds may not be parked at a bicycle rack. Permits can be purchased at the TPS Office. All garages have Motorcycle & Moped parking areas.

Hourly & Pay by Phone Parking (MobilePay)

After parking your vehicle, pay immediately using MobilePay on your mobile device or via pay station. To use MobilePay look for MobilePay signage and follow steps to enter your license plate number and payment

Event Parking/Transportation

Monarch Transit SafeRide

Transportation & Parking Services offers transportation to on-campus, as well as off-campus destinations with Monarch Transit Shuttles. ODU ID is required to board Monarch Transit.

SafeRide

With SafeRide you can Request a ride home at night instead of walking. Rides are available between Magnolia Ave (North) and 38th Street (South), as well as, the Elizabeth River (West) and Colly Ave (East). ODU ID is required to board SafeRide.

Transloc App

Download the Transloc App to track Monarch Transit Shuttles in real time and request a SafeRide Van. Trips for SafeRide MUST be requested through the Transloc App.



Transportation & Parking Services has partnered with HRT to provide subsidized GoPass365 passes valid on all buses, light rail, and ferries. Passes are valid July 1st - June 30th. Route schedules, stops, and other information can be found at gohrt.com. Passes must be purchased at the ODU TPS Office with an ODU ID.
