Subject: Annual Report of Sponsored Program Activity - June 30, 2003

Attached please find the Annual Report of Sponsored Program Activity for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2003. This report measures sponsored program activity administered through Old Dominion University Research Foundation by the amount of expenditures (direct costs and indirect cost recoveries) incurred during the fiscal year. This report includes sponsored program activity administered by the Research Foundation for Old Dominion University and for certain independent entities affiliated with the university. The report also includes, as other research related activity, revenues and expenditures of the Langley Full Scale Tunnel.

Included in the current year's report is a schedule of proposals submitted and awards funded for the four most recent fiscal years. Proposal activity is based upon the total dollar amount requested from sponsoring agencies exclusive of institutional or third party cost share amounts. Award activity reflects the dollar amount of actual funding committed during the reporting period.

Some key points to note are as follows:

- Sponsored program activity increased by 3.11% to a level of \$33.5 million
- The average yearly increase for the past five fiscal periods is 11.92%
- The top five funding sources for the fiscal year were:

National Space and Aeronautics Administration	\$6.7 million
U.S. Department of the Navy	\$5.9 million
National Science Foundation	\$3.9 million
Virginia Department of Education	\$1.8 million
U.S. Department of the Air Force	\$1.5 million

These five agencies represent 59.1% of total sponsored research activity

- University departments (including SSRP's) with activity exceeding \$1 million for the fiscal year were:

Virginia Modeling, Analysis and Simulation Center	\$6.0 million
Biological Sciences	\$2.8 million
Center for Advanced Engineering Environments	\$1.7 million
Ocean, Earth and Atmospheric Sciences	\$1.7 million
Early Childhood, Speech Language Pathology and Special Education	\$1.6 million
Center for Bioelectrics	\$1.5 million
Center for Coastal Physical Oceanography	\$1.4 million
Electrical & Computer Engineering	\$1.2 million

- Proposal submissions during fiscal year 2003 increased 21.02% over fiscal year 2002 levels and represent an average yearly increase of 26.67% for the four year period since fiscal year 1999. Funding awarded remained relatively stable at \$32.2 million dollars for fiscal year 2003, versus \$32.4 million dollars in fiscal year 2002.

The following charts graphically depict current fiscal year research expenditures and the trend in research activity over the past six years:

Chart A – Research Expenditures for University and Non-University Units

This chart indicates percentage of total research expenditures for fiscal year 2003 for each college and other reporting units.

Chart B – Expenditures by Funding Source

This chart indicates the growth in sponsored research from \$20.9 million for fiscal year 1998 to \$33.5 million dollars for fiscal year 2003. This information represents expenditures incurred by funding source (Federal, State & Local, and Private Sponsors).




Chart A – Research Expenditures for University and Non-University Units




Chart B – Expenditures by Funding Source
